

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DAMON RUN CONSERVANCY DISTRICT SEWER RATE ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE CONNECTION CHARGE PAYABLE TO THE DAMON RUN CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Damon Run Conservancy District ("District") enacted its Ordinance No. 2006-2 titled Sewer Use Ordinance ("Sewer Use Ordinance") which Sewer Use Ordinance established, among other things, a schedule of rates and charges regarding the use and operation of the District's sewage works; and

WHEREAS, upon review of information and recommendation of the District's accountant, the Board of the District has determined that it is necessary amend the Sewer Use Ordinance to make certain adjustment to the connection charges associated with the District's sewage works.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DAMON RUN CONSERVANCY DISTRICT, PORTER COUNTY, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:


1. **Incorporation of Recitals.** The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.
2. **Amendment to Section 4 District Connection Charge.** Section 4 of the Sewer Use Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. District Connection Charge. A District Connection Charge per equivalent single family dwelling unit ("ESFDU") will be collected from new customers of the Sewage System in accordance with the following schedule:



| Portage Connection Charge   | \$2,200 |
| Damon Run Connection Charge | \$2,500 |
| Total Charge per ESFDU      | \$4,700 |

3. **Scope and Effect.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Except as expressly modified and amended herein, the Sewer Use Ordinance shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
